In 2009, the Welsh Assembly Government published “*A Community Nursing Strategy for Wales*”. This set out the vision for the future services in Wales that will ‘provide holistic care with a nursing workforce that is flexible, adaptable and knowledgeable’.

In December 2011, nurses working in the community or with community nurses met to develop by consensus a Strategy for the development of research for community nurses.
